Eugene F. "Gene" Deady, 82, of Newport, beloved husband, father, and grandfather died Monday, January 15, 2018 at Village House Nursing Home. Gene was born on March 9, 1935 in Holyoke, MA, the son of the late E. Thomas and Madeline (Ryan) Deady. He was the husband of the late Arlene (St. Cyr) Deady.
